Twilight Breaking Dawn: Part 2 Fright or Delight?

Twilight fans have been eagerly awaiting the conclusion of this vampire saga. So, does the fourth instalment live up to the high expectations of those of you who are Twihard fans? The answer is yes!

This film takes up the story after the birth of Edward and Bella's daughter, and Bella's conversion into a vampire. It is a big improvement on Breaking Dawn: Part 1 as it has a lot more action!

There are some interesting new vampire characters from around the world, but also lots of old favourites. The Volturi, led by Aro, are particularly nasty, while there is plenty of bare-chested action from Jacob for his fans! Faint! The film builds to a fantastic finale; the battle scene is amazing to look at and there is a truly surprising twist in the tale which left the whole movie theatre gasping.

Although Robert Pattinson and Kristin Stewart continue to dazzle as the beautiful Edward and Bella, there is something strange about seeing them (un-aging) with a growing teenage daughter. Also, there is a twist in the tale for fans of Jacob that some may find a bit uncomfortable. Despite these drawbacks, the story does work and it is visually stunning.

Overall, this is a great film for fans of the books and for fans of the film. It will appeal mostly to girls, but boys may enjoy the fight scenes (and the chance to snuggle up close to a scared girl?!). There is a lot of sex and violence, so unfortunately you under fifteens won't be able to watch it (not at the cinema anyway; you may be able to persuade your parents to let you watch at home).
